1. COURSE DESCRIPTION
1.1. Course objectives
The aim is to familiarize students with the characteristics of certain periods in the history of ancient art, and introduce them to basic historical facts pertaining to these periods. Students will become acquainted with basic concepts related to material culture, urbanism, architecture, sculpture, painting and crafts of a certain period. Furthermore, they will be able to interpret and compare the most important monuments. Students will improve the basic writing skills and be able to write seminar papers and give presentations.

Students will be able to define basic periods in the history of ancient art, from the first artistic achievements in the prehistoric age to the fall of the Western Roman Empire.
