1. COURSE DESCRIPTION

1.1. Course objectives

The course aims to a) familiarize students with the most important issues, works and authors in the philosophy of science; b) explain the relevance of science and scientific findings for philosophical issues, world image formation, and traditional anthropological questions; c) point out some specific philosophical issues pertaining to singular scientific fields.

1.2. Course enrolment requirements and entry competences required for the course

1.3. Expected course learning outcomes

- 1) improving the use of the philosophical approach to science, particularly natural sciences
- 2) enabling students to increase their knowledge of scientific practice, and gain a proper understanding of how significant scientific practice is for traditional philosophical issues
- 3) improving the quality of research studies (related to the process of writing a seminar paper) conducted by students
- 4) helping students to do research independently (in the form of an essay)
- 5) improving the quality of students' oral presentation (i.e. the presentation of the acquired knowledge, as well as the findings of students' research)
