Aims and objectives of foreign language teaching. Language skills in foreign language teaching (pronunciation, orthography, grammar and vocabulary). The development of receptive and productive language skills. Knowledge (self-)assessment. Error analysis and correction. Function and use of teaching tools and resources. Analysis and evaluation of teaching materials. Interaction in foreign language teaching. Culture and civilization in foreign language teaching. Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. Research methods in foreign language teaching.
