1. COURSE DESCRIPTION

1.1. Course objectives

The aim of the course is to draw students' attention to political and social changes that emerged in Italy during the 20th century. Particular emphasis shall be placed on the rise, course and consequences of the "red" and "black" terrorism in the '70s, the development of the "strategies of tension", neo-fascist attacks, the left-wing extremism of the Red Brigades.
