#### 1. COURSE DESCRIPTION

##### 1.1. Course objectives

- The objective is to familiarize students with clinical psychologists' area of interest and functions in different contexts, as well as the opportunities for education and training in clinical psychology. This course provides a theoretical overview on the possibilities of applying clinical psychology in different settings.

##### 1.2. Course enrolment requirements and entry competences required for the course

- By the end of the course, students will be able to:
  - distinguish between the responsibilities and roles that a clinical psychologist assumes in different areas of clinical work;

  - distinguish between different methods in psychotherapy.

##### 1.4. Course content

- Familiarizing students with the notion of normality and theoretical models used in clinical psychology. Students become acquainted with the phases of clinical evaluation, clinical evaluation methods, the basic features of different clinical interventions, and the prevention of mental disorders. The course will also touch upon some of the specific areas of clinical psychology, such as: clinical child psychology, clinical neuropsychology, health psychology and forensic clinical psychology.
