#### 1. COURSE DESCRIPTION

##### 1.1. Course objectives

- The aim of the course is to develop written and oral language competence, gain the familiarity with different methods of text analysis, develop students' understanding of grammatical rules, as well as their ability to apply these rules.

- Pronouns and their usage (stressed and unstressed - atoni and tonici); reading and applying grammatical rules;
- Indicative mood (tenses) – Modo Indicativo – Imperfetto, Trapassato prossimo, Trapassato remoto, future anteriore (their usage and functions) – Functions: remembering, forgetting, showing surprise – their use in conversational contexts;
- Reflexive verbs – forma riflessiva – Dialogue/usage;
- Irregular verbs: dare, aprire, cadere, chiudere, fare.
