1. COURSE DESCRIPTION

1.1. Course objectives

- The aim of the course is to develop written and oral language competence, gain the familiarity with different methods of text analysis, develop students' understanding of grammatical rules, as well as their ability to apply these rules.

1.2. Course enrolment requirements and entry competences required for the course

- Completion of the following courses: *Lingua italiana 1* and *Lingua italiana 2*.

1.3. Expected course learning outcomes

- By the end of the course, students will be able to:
 - use the conditional mood accurately
 - know complex verb tenses
 - know irregular verbs
 - use the imperative mood
 - explain the basic grammatical rules (regarding grammatical moods, the imperative mood, dative pronouns and irregular verbs).

1.4. Course content

- The conditional mood (Condizionale) – the present tense and the past tense – Functions: making excuses, expressing fear, seeking explanation;
- Dative pronouns – combined pronouns. Functions: specifying, responding, expressing wishes, ability or inability to do a certain activity – adverbs/prepositions;
- Irregular verbs: correggere, correre, mettere and condurre;
- Complex verb tenses – pronouns; Reading and applying grammatical rules;
- The imperative mood, its usage and function – Functions: the knowledge function, seeking information, giving recommendation, being tolerant, making observations – Dialogue – usage
