#### 1. COURSE DESCRIPTION

##### 1.1. Course objectives

- The aim of the course is to acquire written and oral language competence, familiarize students with different methods of text analysis, develop students' understanding of grammatical rules, as well as their ability to apply these rules.

##### 1.2. Course enrolment requirements and entry competences required for the course

##### 1.3. Expected course learning outcomes

- Upon completing the course and fulfilling their responsibilities, students will be able to:
  - pronounce the Italian words properly - the manner of articulation and sentence intonation
  - interpret a given text (basic language analysis and text-paraphrasing)
  - develop communicative skills
  - determine basic grammatical rules (orthographic norms, the use of auxiliary verbs, the present tense, the perfect tense)
  - broaden their knowledge of grammar, as well as to apply the acquired knowledge in oral

and written communication.

#### 1.4. Course content

- The orthographic norms of the standard language – principles and expressive means (text analysis) - reading grammatical rules and applying them when stressing certain syllables;
- The verb *be* and the verb *have* (present, past and future - Modo Indicativo - presente, passato prossimo and futuro semplice) – their usage and functions – Functions: introductions and greetings – Conjugations ARE-ERE-IRE;
- Articles and their usage (definite and indefinite articles – articoli determinativi e indeterminativi e uso) – Responding to greetings - Dialogue;
- Names and adjectives (possessive/demonstrative adjectives) – Practical usage - telephone conversation;
- Irregular verbs: *volere*, *potere*, *dovere*, *andare*, *venire* and their usage;
- Numbers and hours - oral production - communication;
- Prepositions - simple or articulated: *preposizioni semplici e articolate* – function and usage of Italian prepositions – the corresponding Croatian and Latin cases - Practical usage – writing a letter.
