- First contacts: Slavic migrations and the Romance culture of the Illyrians.
- The Venetian influence in Dalmatia.

- The formation of Italian and multicultural centers on the Eastern Adriatic coast (local contacts and ties).
- Croatian humanists at Italian Universities.
- Petrarchism and Croatian Renaissance Literature.
- The early modern period and the construction of Croatian and Italian national discourse (Tomaseo and the Italian / Illyrian revival).
- The contacts between historical avant-gardes; Dannunzianism in Rijeka.
- Italian fascism and anti-fascism on the Eastern Adriatic coast.
- The Italian Republic and SFRY: the decades of controversies and dialogue (the great Adriatic exodus, the Trieste crisis, the dialogue after the Treaty of Osimo).
- The artistic production of Italian and Croatian minority groups seen as a bridge between cultures.
- Historical revisionism and the question of European partnership.
