1. COURSE DESCRIPTION

1.1. Course objectives

The objective of the course is to define and analyse the basic principles of Italian culture and society in the course of modern Italian history and particularly, in the XIX and XX centuries; to explain the political, social and cultural changes within XX century Italy.

1.2. Course enrolment requirements and entry competences required for the course

1.3. Expected course learning outcomes

The aim is to interest students for Italian history and culture, show the mechanisms and consequences of specific cultural and political phenomena within the modern and contemporary Italian society. Students are expected to actively participate at classes, discussions and at critical analysis of suggested topics.

The aim of this course is to analyse cultural phenomena and historical events of modern and contemporary Italy (especially in the XX century), through lectures and seminars. Particular attention will be given to cultural, political and social phenomena, before and after the 19th century Italian unification, during the liberal Italy (20th century), during I World War and postwar Italy, during the Fascist Italy and during the Italian Republic. The course will focus on the analysis of intellectual, artistic and political movements of XX century Italy, from Fascism to democracy, from the postwar economic crises to the economic success of the "Italian miracle", from the political movements of the sixties and seventies until the fall of the First Italian Republic and Berlusconi.
