1. COURSE DESCRIPTION
1.1. Course objectives
The aim of this course is to enable students to observe lessons in the mentor teachers' classes and teach Italian language and literature in primary and secondary schools.

1.4. Course content
It is estimated that a total of 15 working days per semester will be devoted to pre-service training. Students are divided into smaller groups (up to 10 students) and participate in pre-service training in primary and secondary schools. Pre-service training includes: introducing students to pre-service teachers' training schools and mentor teachers, a certain number of hours of classroom observation, writing two lesson plans and teaching two lessons (one in an elementary school and one in a secondary school).
